**expresses concern at the situation in Georgia**

Javier SOLANA, EU High Representative for the Common Foreign and Security Policy (CFSP), voiced concern today at the latest developments in Georgia:

*“I am concerned about the latest developments in Georgia.*

*Political differences should be resolved within the democratic institutions.*

*All sides should therefore resume the dialogue and refrain from actions that contribute to tensions. This is the best way out of the crisis.*

*I have transmitted this message to President Saakashvili and to the Georgian opposition.*

*I have asked my Special Representative for the South Caucasus, Peter Semneby, to go to Tbilisi on my behalf and to meet with all sides.”*
