**Declaration by the High Representative on behalf of the
European Union on the alignment of certain third countries
with the Council Decision 2011/332/CFSP and Council Decision
2011/345/CFSP implementing Council Decision 2011/137/CFSP
concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in
Libya**

On 7 June 2011, the Council adopted Council Decision 2011/332/CFSP¹. The Council Decision amends the lists of persons and entities subject to restrictive measures as set out in Annex IV to Decision 2011/137/CFSP.

On 16 June 2011, the Council adopted Council Decision 2011/345/CFSP². The Council Decision amends the lists of persons and entities subject to restrictive measures as set out in Annex IV to Decision 2011/137/CFSP.

This declaration is made to announce that the following countries have declared that they share the objectives of Council Decision 2011/332/CFSP and Council Decision 2011/345/CFSP:
