Declaration by the High Representative on behalf of the European Union on the alignment of certain third countries with the Council Decision 2011/701/CFSP amending Decision 2011/430/CFSP in order to update the list of persons, groups and entities subject to Articles 2, 3 and 4 of Common Position 2001/931/CFSP on the application of specific measures to combat terrorism

On 21 October 2011, the Council adopted Council Decision 2011/701/CFSP<sup>1</sup>. The Council Decision amends the list of persons, groups and entities subject to the measures provided for in Common Position 2001/931/CFSP on the application of specific measures to combat terrorism.

This declaration is made to announce that the following countries have declared that they share the objectives of Council Decision 2011/701/CFSP:

The Candidate Countries Croatia\*, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia\* and Montenegro\* the Countries of the Stabilisation and Association Process and potential candidates Albania and Serbia, and the EFTA country Liechtenstein, member of the European Economic Area, as well as the Republic of Moldova.

<sup>\*</sup> Croatia, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia and Montenegro continue to be part of the Stabilisation and Association Process.
