**JAVIER SOLANA,

welcomes the agreement to form a new government in Serbia**

Javier SOLANA, EU High Representative for the Common Foreign and Security Policy (CFSP) welcomed the agreement reached by Serbian leaders to form a new government and made the following statement:

"I have heard with great pleasure that the leaders of the reform-oriented, pro-European parties have today reached an agreement to form a new government. This decision comes at a crucial moment for the future of Serbia. I expect a swift and smooth process in the parliament to vote in the new government so that they quickly and determinately can continue the necessary reforms for Serbia to move closer to the EU and contribute to positive regional development and stability.

It is now up to Serbia to make the vision of its European future a practical reality. The European Union will fully support Serbia in this endeavour. "
