Reducing climate impacts from international aviation: Europe leads the way



This Video focuses on legislation proposed by the European Commission to bring the aviation sector into the European Union's pioneering emissions trading scheme (EU ETS) in order to control the rapid growth in CO2 emissions from air travel. Until now, airlines have not been subject to constraints on energy consumption or greenhouse gas emissions. Emissions from domestic flights are subject to the Kyoto Protocol's emission targets for developed countries, but international flights – which make up the vast majority – are not.
