**Declaration by the Presidency on behalf of the European Union
on the Council Common Position 2009/139/CFSP of 16
February 2009, renewing restrictive measures against the
leadership of the Transnistrian region of the Republic of
Moldova**

The Candidate Countries Turkey, Croatia* and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia*, the Countries of the Stabilisation and Association Process and potential candidates Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Serbia, and the EFTA countries Liechtenstein and Norway, members of the European Economic Area, as well as Georgia declare that they share the objectives of **Council Common Position 2009/139/CFSP of 16 February 2009, renewing restrictive measures against the leadership of the Transnistriatn region of the Republic of Moldova** which was published on 17 February 2009 in the Official Journal of the European Union N° L 46 p.76.

They will ensure that their national policies conform to this Common Position.
