Access to the Summit:

At the security control (security desk at the entrance of the Press Centre in the Justus Lipsius building) media representatives must present:

Journalists and technicians already accredited to the European Institutions:

- the interinstitutional press card (yellow badge) or the 6-month badge.

Other cases :

- a valid passport (or if you are a national of a Member State of the European Union, an EFTA country or an EEA country, your valid national identity card),
- AND a valid press card (or if you are a media representative from a country which does not issue press cards, the ORIGINAL of a letter (faxes will not be accepted) from the editor of your media organisation, signed by the editor-in-chief, specifying your professional status).

Please note that no access will be possible without these documents.
